

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
Monitoring Reporting Requirements Not Met for
WILDERNESS PSD WV3303405

Our water system violated drinking water monitoring requirements. Even though these were not emergencies, you, as our customers, have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During periods listed in the table below, we did not monitor or test as required and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

At this time, there is nothing you need to do.

The table below lists the monitoring we did not conduct, other violations, and the associated compliance period.

What happened? What is being done? (Describe corrective action)

We do Lead and Copper testing once every 3 years. After our testing ended in 2021 we had made a change in one of our sample sites. When collecting our samples for the 2024 sampling period we had mistakenly collected our samples using our 2021 approved sample site list instead of our new revised sample sites for 2024 effectively excluding our one new sample site. We have discarded the old sample site plan in order to try to prevent anything like this from happening again.

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What happened? What is being done? (Describe corrective action)

We take five Bacteriological samples every month from 10 different approved sample sites. Durring the month of January 2024 our sampler mistakenly went to the same sites that had already been tested resulting in missing Bacteriological samples from the correct sites. A monthly sample site confirmation sheet is now being used in an attempt to prevent this from happening again.
